Good practices

- O The student handbook of the Department of Clinical Engineering in the Faculty of Health Care Sciences not only details the three policies but also explains in an easily understood manner the meaning of the policies and the relationships between each of them. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- O With regard to learning and class instruction support, under the collaboration between faculty and staff, the state of each student is appropriately ascertained through regularly conducted student interviews and learning portfolios that the students themselves fill in. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- O In order to resolve problems and anxieties about study and school life, a Flow Process for the Sharing and Organizational Responses to Student Consultation and Complaint Information has been created and approaches are made through university-wide collaboration between faculty and staff. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- O In order to improve and design educational content, class observations of all classes are conducted on a mutual basis by faculty, and the way that the results of this are fed back to those in charge of the classes is worthy of high evaluation.
- O FD (Faculty development) and SD (staff development) training is implemented once every one to two months, and is enthusiastically held under all sorts of themes such as the handling of personal information and support of disabled students. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

O The number of enrolled students in the new ongoing Department of Clinical Engineering in the Faculty of Health Care Sciences is under 50% of the yearly enrollment quotas. Improvements are required to maintain an appropriate number of student enrollments.
