Good practices

- A learning and class instruction support setup using systems including the advisor system and the office hours system has been developed and this initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- Advisors and those in charge of teaching exchange information and provide student assistance, regularly implement meetings between students and faculty members, and contribute to the resolution of issues in school life. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The implementation rate of active learning is high, eagerly implemented by both departments, and educational methods emphasizing bi-directional learning are used. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- IR (Institutional Research) reports with a focus on important issues are created by the IR section and IR committee. Based on the reports, IR report meetings are regularly held aimed at all faculty and staff, and learning outcomes inspected in detail. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- Towards securing a stable financial base as the university's incorporated entity, a new mid- and long-term plan including the reform of finances needs to be formulated and improvements are required.
