- The fill rate of total capacity in the Faculty of Health Sciences' Department of Physical Therapy is under 70%, and urgent measures and improvements are required.
- In line with the assessment policy established in the academic year 2023, improvements are required to create and implement a system to conduct the inspection and evaluation of learning outcomes and provide feedback on their results.
- There are matters needing improvement regarding the inspection and evaluation of learning outcomes. Since there are major issues concerning the functionality of the internal quality assurance of education, improvements are required in order to create and implement the related system.
