Good practices

- The college's teaching solutions positively encourage students to study according to the diploma policy and its relation to the provided courses through use of a curriculum tree, and the college also keeps improving teaching methods as well. These initiatives are well evaluated.

Recommendations for improvement

- The president has not established important educational and research matters about which the president must obtain the opinion from the faculty council and graduate school committee as stipulated in Article 93, paragraph (2) of the School Education Act. This situation must be remedied.
- The college has not established procedures for the withdrawal and suspension of, or warning to students as stipulated in Article 26, paragraph (5) of the Enforcement Regulation of the School Education Act. This situation must be remedied.
- Matters regarding Article 93 of the School Education Act and student's compliance need to be remedied, since the college's internal quality assurance about these matters does not function well.
