Research study on the engagement of stakeholders (especially students) in Quality Assurance of higher education in Europe

The purpose of this research is to clarify the European system and actual conditions of stakeholder (especially students) engagement in quality assurance of higher education, and to use this information to improve the evaluation system of the Japan Institution for Higher Education Evaluation (JIHEE). We asked the question, "What is stakeholder engagement in Quality Assurance as practiced in Europe and can it be introduced to Japan?" We conducted a literature review, and then conducted interviews and a questionnaire survey to more deeply understand the actual situation.

Interviews were conducted online with three Quality Assurance-related organizations and four universities in the UK. Through these interviews, it was found that the quality assurance-related organizations practice the idea that "the answer to what higher education should be lies entirely in the students". During the university interviews, we were able to hear many good practices that were appropriate to the individuality and background of the universities.

The questionnaire survey was conducted through an online system, targeting members of students affiliated to the European Students' Union (ESU). They were asked about their experiences as members of students review panels, the results obtained from their evaluation activities, and the challenges of student engagement in Quality Assurance. We found that student engagement is regarded as an essential condition for Quality Assurance in Europe, that students are passionate about protecting their rights, and that they are tackling various challenges in order to promote student engagement.

The results obtained from these surveys will be useful in considering the design of a Japanese-style stakeholder (especially students) engagement system.
